



Day 1 Friday 21 October

Experience this retail haven with 450 outlets offering the finest fashion and home furnishing to entertainment and culinary delights. Let the endless appeal of Malaysia's premier shopping destination awaken your senses the moment you arrive at its doorstep. Try out the Fish Spa for tired and aching feet—quite an experience!

For those who would like to experience some more Malaysia, there are optional tours to the historic trading city of Malacca or out into the countryside where quaint 'kampung' houses stand side by side with palatial homes.

Day 5 Tuesday 25 October

Petaling Street and Jalan Bandar are at the hub of Kuala Lumpur's bustling Chinatown. Shops here offer a variety of textiles, clothes, shoes and handbags at bargain prices. The area is also known for its jewellery shops with their fascinating variety of fine jewellery items beautifully crafted in gold and set with priceless gemstones. Traders offer exotic ethnic jewellery, wall hangings, ornaments, curios and teapots. Make-shift and mobile stalls jam the streets with their offerings.

Day 6 Wednesday 26 October

Last day! Chance to revisit some of your favourite places, do more shopping or simply relax before your journey home tomorrow.

Transfer to Kuala Lumpur International airport for your flight home to Australia. *Additional nights or Singapore extension available on request.*
